

# {Fast~Support}Can I upgrade my flight if it's booked through Chase Travel? (Complete 2026 Guide)

Yes, in many cases you can upgrade a Chase Travel ☎️ ||+1→888→483→9719 booking, but you must follow the airline's upgrade rules because Chase Travel acts like an online travel agency, not the airline itself. ☎️ ||+1→888→483→9719
